



Dear ATP Friends,

Thanks for buying tickets for **All Tomorrow's Parties – End Of An Era Part 1** curated by ATP & **Primavera Sound**.

You will either shortly be receiving your tickets in the post, or this letter will explain how to check-in with your e-tickets/online ticket booking. When received, please check that you have the right amount of tickets for your order, if there is a problem you need to go back to the agent where you bought the tickets **before** you make your way to the site. We will not make any changes once you are there. Please note if you are a non UK customer or booked via the ATP Store, Wegottickets or Ticketscript you will not have been posted tickets so you will not need them to check-in – you need to print off your booking email or bring your booking code – see below for more info.

Please see the 'What You Need To Provide' section below for an important note about Linens - which Pontins will not be providing for these two events.

Another important note to remember (and that many people forget, though we do mention it on site before you buy!) is that every chalet on site contains one double sofabed alongside the single beds – and this will need to be shared by two attendees in your chalet. So please bear this in mind and let your fellow chalet dwellers know in advance so it's not a surprise when you arrive.

Please read through the following information VERY carefully and please be sure to complete any necessary additional documents required before arriving onsite.

ATP Terms and Conditions:

Conditions Of Sale:

- 1) All conditions in this letter to be read together with all other statements or directives that may be displayed on the premises.
- 2) If the event is cancelled for any reason, only the face value of the ticket will be refunded. If the event is abandoned due to the forces of nature or any reason, refunds are at the promoter's discretion.
- 3) Tickets will not be exchanged or replaced nor money refunded after purchase.
- 4) The promoter reserves the right to change the listed bill and/or the date of the event without prior notification. In the event of change of date or line-up, refunds will not be available.
- 5) We play Rain or Shine.
- 6) Should this ticket be resold or transferred for profit or commercial gain it will become void and the ticket holder may be refused entry to, or ejected from the venue. This condition specifically, prohibits ticket re-sale through online market or auction sites.
- 7) Tickets cannot be purchased for use in unauthorised promotions/competitions. 'All Tomorrow's Parties' is a registered trademark and cannot be used without promoter consent.
- 8) In the case that accommodation becomes unavailable due to un-repairable damage prior to the event taking place, the organisers reserve the right to cancel your tickets, giving a minimum of 24 hours notice of the event taking place. If in the event that this does happen you will be refunded in full including any ticket booking fees that you may have incurred. We will not be held liable for any personal costs that you may have incurred i.e.: travel costs.

Conditions Of Entry:

- 1) Right of admission is reserved. Entry is at own risk.
- 2) The promoter and venue shall not be liable for any loss or injury or damages sustained on or within the premises.
- 3) Ticket holders consent to their filming and sound recording as members of the audience
- 4) No weapons, fireworks, illicit drugs will be allowed onto the site. Anyone caught in possession of such substances, supply or buying illicit drugs will be evicted from the site, reported to the police and may face criminal prosecution.
- 5) The promoters will not be held liable for any hearing damage or loss. Use earplugs if necessary.
- 6) No professional type cameras or recording equipment will be allowed in the venues on site.
- 7) Anyone caught defacing or causing damage to the site in anyway will be evicted from the site and will face criminal prosecution.

Damages

As the purchaser of these tickets you also agree that you are personally responsible for any damages caused to your accommodation by either yourself or your guests. A list will be placed in your apartment detailing the costs of replacing the items and also the cost to windows, doors etc please check that nothing is missing in your apartment when you arrive and if there are items missing please notify the reception staff immediately. Please complete the attached credit card authorisation form and present along with your nominated credit card at check-in. You will be

notified of any damage to your apartment along with any charges to your credit card.



If you do not bring the necessary completed insurance disclaimer form you will not be allowed access to the site.

Checking In – PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY

The person who made the booking needs to be present when you are checking in, and you all need to arrive at the same time to avoid mishaps with tickets etc. You need to have your credit or debit card that you booked with and provide your booking reference/email and all tickets for your apartment when checking in and then in turn you will be given everyone's wristbands for the weekend. If one of your party is arriving later, once you have checked in you can ask the reception staff to leave one of the wristbands in an envelope for them to collect later. Please ensure that you give their full name, and also do not forget to mark down the room number/location of where you are staying.

If your parents or someone else made the booking, or if the person who booked is not the first of you that arrives, you will need to bring a photocopy (both sides) of the credit card used to buy, and a short note explaining that they purchased the tickets on your behalf / you are checking in on their behalf. Please make sure the document includes your name and their signature. You will then need to provide identification to show that you are actually this person.

PLEASE NOTE: Once you have been given the wristband it is your responsibility to make arrangements with your missing friends to meet up, and also to NOT misplace their wristband, as we do not hand out replacements! If you break your wristband you will need to bring the broken one to reception.

To check in you will need to provide the following:

- 1: Your full name
- 2: Your Booking Reference number / Booking email
- 3: Your tickets (Please note If you are a non UK customer or booked via ATP, Wegottickets or ticketscript you will not have been posted tickets so you will not need them to check-in)
- 4: Completed name and address sheet (attached)
- 5: Completed credit card authorisation form for damages (attached)

It is a license requirement for Pontins that you provide us with the full name and address of each person staying in your apartment – please complete before you arrive, as you will not be allowed onsite unless this is completed – you have been warned!

When checking-in your patience is appreciated, we have nearly 3000 customers to check-in to their accommodation and it does take a bit of time but we do our best. Please follow instructions by resort/ATP staff on arrival regarding where to check-in and procedure. Please also make sure to pickup your free programmes, timecards and TV programme when you check-in!

We will be checking in from midday on Friday - however, access to your accommodation is not guaranteed until 4pm on Friday afternoon so Pontins can ensure that all rooms have been cleaned etc.

Check Out is strictly by 10am Monday morning – if you do not checkout by 10am you will incur a late check out charge of £150.00. The site is open for business on Monday morning and Pontins have new customers arriving so please try to be prompt so the cleaning staff can do their jobs.

If venues are full then security will operate on a one in - one out basis.

Apartment Keys

Keys will be given to you at check-in, extra keys can be made available for a small charge please ask reception staff at check-in but please note we are very busy on the first check-in day so it may be easier to get this done on

Saturday.



Accessibility

Pontins Resort facilities are fully accessible – please enquire at the reception for directions to use the lift to gain access to the Fun Factory.

Ch-ch-ch-changes

Please note that from time to time scheduling changes are necessary on the weekend. Please keep your eye out for posters around the site detailing these and keep an eye on twitter.com/atpfestival

What WE Provide!

The event is held in a holiday resort so all tickets include a pass to the festival + 3 nights accommodation in private apartments. Each chalet is self-catering and has a small kitchen with cooking/dining utensils included, bathroom with either a shower or bath and of course a sink & toilet. The TV area doubles as a bedroom with a roll out double sofa bed, and then there will either be one or two bedrooms with the relevant number of additional beds. *Quilts and Pillows are provided but Linens are NOT – see below for details on that.*

So you basically stay on site in your own private accommodation with your friends for 3 nights and you also get a pass to see all of the bands perform over 3 days, plus bar with DJs until early in the morning, free cinema programme, use of site facilities and much more! Apart from nursing a hangover, there is a swimming pool, arcades, a beautiful beach across the road, the local pubs and of course Rye Village where there are some very nice places to eat. Camber Sands is easily accessible via train to Rye (followed by a short bus/taxi ride).

In addition to the onsite Pontins food options we will be bringing some outside food vendors for extra choice.

What YOU Need To Provide!

You need to provide your own FOOD, DRINK, LINENS (see below), TOILETRIES including TOWELS/TOILET PAPER, HAIRDRYERS, and STRAIGHTENING IRONS etc etc.

Unfortunately Pontins have informed us that unlike past ATP events, for these two final events they will not be providing linens free for each chalet. We're sorry to have to let you know about this inconvenience - but sadly this policy could not be changed.

They asked us to pass on the following information:

Linen can be purchased on park for £10 for a single set, £20 for a double set. Towels can also be purchased @ £5 per towel.

*A single set will be one pillowcase, one single sheet and one single duvet cover.
A double set will be two pillowcases, one double sheet and one double duvet cover.*

Every chalet contains one double sofa bed and then additional single beds up to the total number of berths.

You are of course totally welcome (and we would highly recommend) that you just bring your own sheets/pillowcases (or maybe a sleeping bag if you prefer that) and towels with you so you do not have to pay for anything. And if you want to make the place more homely/cosy you may wish to bring your own favourite pillow/duvet/blanket/snuggie.

For supplies locally - there is one supermarket on the site and one across the road from the site 'BJs on the Beach', plus a great farm shop less than 10 mins drive away which sells local produce (cheese, ales etc), excellent ready meals plus does good coffee and bacon sandwiches. <http://www.saltsfarmshop.co.uk/>

There are also shops and supermarkets in Rye a few minutes drive away in case you want to stock up before travelling down to Camber Sands.

Alcohol

Pontins request that all festival attendees do not bring excessive quantities of alcohol onto the resort. The quantity that is deemed excessive will be at the discretion of Pontins. If any ATP attendees ignore this, their alcohol will be removed and returned at the end of the weekend. If any attendees repeatedly ignore this, they may be asked to leave Pontins.



Pontins won't be performing vehicle searches for the ATP weekend but they, and we, do request that you try not to openly flaunt the policy on excessive amounts! If Pontins feel that this request is being ignored then further action might be taken, which could include the searching of vehicles entering the resort, which no-one would like to happen.

Please note, that while you are welcome to bring your own alcohol and drink it in your apartment, you are not permitted to bring any alcohol into the venues. Please be mindful of this whilst on site.

Merch

Merch will be sold in Crocs, which will be indicated on the map in your programme when you arrive on site. Opening times to be advised, but generally they are from approximately 4pm – Midnight Friday, Midday – Midnight Saturday and Midday - 10pm Sunday.

Drugs

We operate a strict zero tolerance drugs policy. Anyone caught in possession of such substances will be removed from the site and reported to the police. No exceptions!

Security

Onsite there will be one security team, our own team from Headline Security.

The security team is there to do a job and 99% of the time they do it extremely well, however if you do have any problems with any of the security staff please do not leave it until after the event has ended as we can't do anything about it then.

They are extremely polite and helpful, so please be polite back to them. They are there to do a job – they are not monsters, if they ask you to move into or out of certain areas they are doing so because there is obviously some kind of risk, be it you are blocking an exit or otherwise. They are not just doing it because they feel like it!

Again we will take all complaints seriously, so do not hesitate to mention anything to us. We want you all to have an amazing time, not a bad one – although please do not complain about the weather as this is definitely out of our control! All you need to do is go to reception and ask for Barry, Deborah, Shaun or Rosalynde and we will be more than happy to help!

If you do feel you need to make a complaint against a member of security try to remember to take down the number on the jacket as this is how we can identify each individual member of staff.

Getting to the Site

The address for SatNavs is Pontins Camber Sands Holiday Park, New Lydd Road, Camber Sands, East Sussex, TN31 7RL

Heading south the simplest route is to take the M20 down to Junction 10.

Onto A2070 towards Brenzett, which is a left-hand turn for Lydd Airport & Brenzette. Then follow signs for Lydd Airport up to the A259 towards Rye & Hastings.

Continue until the left turn for Camber & Lydd Airport, then follow signs for the Pontins Holiday camp.

Parking:

There is fairly limited parking at the site so if you are coming down by car, where possible please arrange to travel down to the site with your friends and reduce your carbon footprint a little. Please do not leave belongings in the car when parking up, as ATP/Pontins will not be held liable for any damages or loss to your vehicle.

By Rail:

The local train station for Camber Sands is called RYE and it is in East Sussex. Once you reach Rye station you can either take a taxi to the site (good numbers to call are...)

Or alternatively take the Wave route/number 100 bus, which departs from Rye Rail Station stop B and which will drop you off directly outside the Pontins site. The journey takes around 15 minutes and you can look up the exact timetable on this link: <http://tinyurl.com/pp5cfwz>

Buses will show either Camber or Lydd (for Dover) on the destination display. The single fare is approx £ 2.80. A return is not available for outward travel on a Friday and return travel on a Monday. We have contacted the bus company regarding putting on extra buses to accommodate the extra demand, which they have done for our

previous events.

By Air:

The nearest airport to ATP is London Gatwick which is only 53 miles away. You can get a train from Gatwick Airport to Rye changing at Lewes and it takes around 2hrs.

Under 18s:

Unfortunately at Pontins the license for our events is for over 18s only and Under 18s will not be permitted.

At The Bar – Requests For ID

If you happen to look young for your age it would be a good idea to carry a drivers license or photo ID to prove your age as ID may be required when buying alcoholic drinks at the bar.

Where Do I Go If I Have A Problem Over The Weekend?

If you have any problem over the weekend, please go to the main reception firstly to see if anyone there can help, or to the production office and ask for Barry, Deborah, Shaun or Rosalynde from ATP. Please do ask on site if you have any questions/problems – we can't change anything once you get home and we want to make sure you have a great time, so any unforeseen problems we can solve we will try to solve during the event!

Medical Problems:

Dear festivals goers,

As per usual, we have a front line ambulance that will be manned for the duration of the festival situated outside the main reception of Pontins. Apart from when our medics are responding to calls this ambulance will be staffed at all times. If at any time the ambulance has to leave site with a patient this will be replaced with a front line ambulance car in the same location.

Medics have full radio contact with all security and production.

If you have any medical issues however minor they may seem please do not hesitate to contact us. You can do this by contacting security, coming to the ambulance or calling the medics mobile

In London we will also be running a very special popup venue at Netil House, Hackney:

ATP's takeover event will be running on weeknights between Monday 18th November, when the mysterious Soundheads kick things off, and Thursday 5th December when Wolf People headline a special **ATP End Of Year Party**. The series features an electric range of music: from newly acclaimed experimental artists like Pharmakon and The Haxan Cloak, to renowned live acts such as The Icarus Line and the legendary Shellac, a rare performance from the reformed Comets On Fire and perhaps the most legendary artist of this series: Michael Rother performing the works of his seminal Krautrock bands Neu! and Harmonia. Tickets range from £10-£20 and capacity is limited to less than 600 people per night, with each event starting from 6.30pm and featuring food vendors, film screenings, DJs, and other activities like whiskey tastings - see our website for info.
