"Noise" remains a foreboding sort of genre, not so welcoming to the casual listener, but Ben Power and Andrew Hung

Power and Andrew Hung have ambitions beyond denting your eardrums. Street Horrrsing's principal antecedents would seem to

be psychedelically minded US bands like Black Dice or early Animal Collective, the likes of "Sweet Love For Planet Earth" powering

along on fuzzed-out synth melodies, and mangled, bust-mike vox. Key, however, is a rhythmic edge
